**Duties:** 

Assists in the development, production, marketing, scheduling, facilitation and delivery of instructor-led and online courses and course material by performing the following duties: Revising and formatting slides; editing, proofreading, and reviewing course scripts; proofreading and editing written and recorded course materials; ensuring accessibility of online courses by adding alternative text for non-text content such as images; formatting documents for screen reader and other assistive technology accessibility; transcribing audio portions of videos; assisting in testing, reviewing, and editing online course materials for accessibility and WCAG 2.0 and Section 508 compliance; registering and communicating with students; and managing enrollment records and class rosters, spreadsheets, and other documents necessary for class management.

**Qualifications:** 

Required qualifications: Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university preferably in Education, English, Training or related field. One year minimum experience in related area. Some experience or knowledge of Section 508 compliance standards and how these standards are applied to written materials, or a willingness to promptly complete Federal training in 508 standards. Experience with writing, proofreading and editing written material. Occasional nationwide travel is required.

Preferred Qualifications:

Experience working with virtual computer environments, a variety of web browsers, eLearning authoring software, and in repurposing course curriculum to an online (virtual) computing environment is preferred.
